CONTEXT


- Population in need of humanitarian assistance: 2.8M
- 1.9M lack access to basic healthcare
- Health facilities destroyed/ damaged: 274–300 (31 health workers injured, 13 killed)
- City and urban centres at IPC "crisis" phase
- Up to 2 million people have been forced displaced due to conflict and insecurity


